Broad support for clean heating

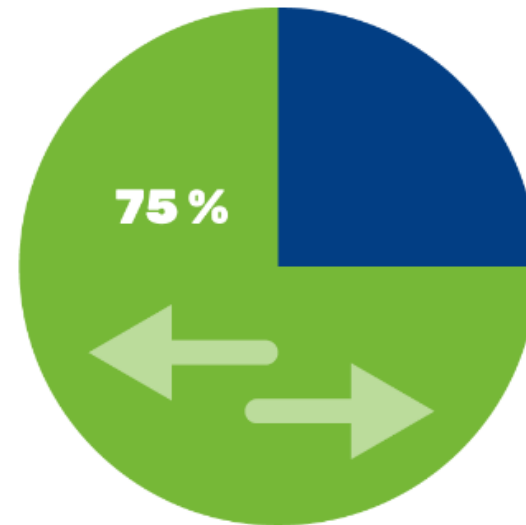
4 out of 5 Austrians see clean heating as important





Broad support for clean heating

75 % support a „renewables-act“ that requires that fossil heating systems will be replaced by climate friendly solutions





Coalition Agreement

- › Climate Neutrality by 2040
- › Renovation Rate of 3 % Green Jobs Initiative
- › 650 Mio EUR (2021/2022) for retrofit in buildings and change of heating system
- › Phase out of oil and gas heating systems
- › Ban of oil heating systems until 2035
- › No new gas heating systems in new buildings until 2025

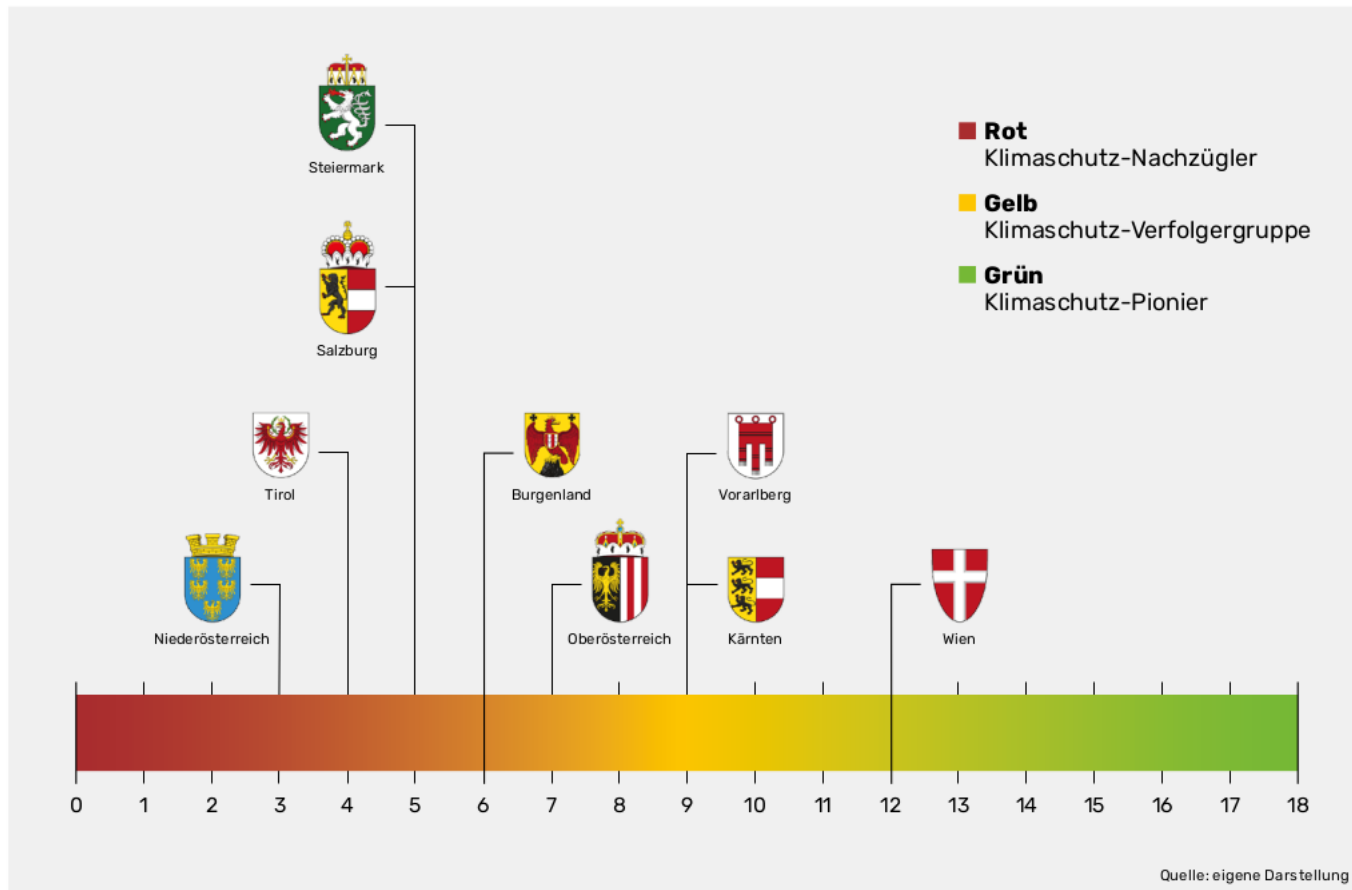

Decarbonisation Plan for Vienna

- Climate zones in spatial planning – 80 % of new buildings without fossil fuels
- Vienna first federal state that has regulation that requires that oil heating systems have to be replaced by climate friendly heating systems
- No new decentralised gas heating systems are allowed
- Plan for decarbonisation of whole building stock by 2022 in elaboration
- Green Gas shall be used for grid stabilisation not for buildings



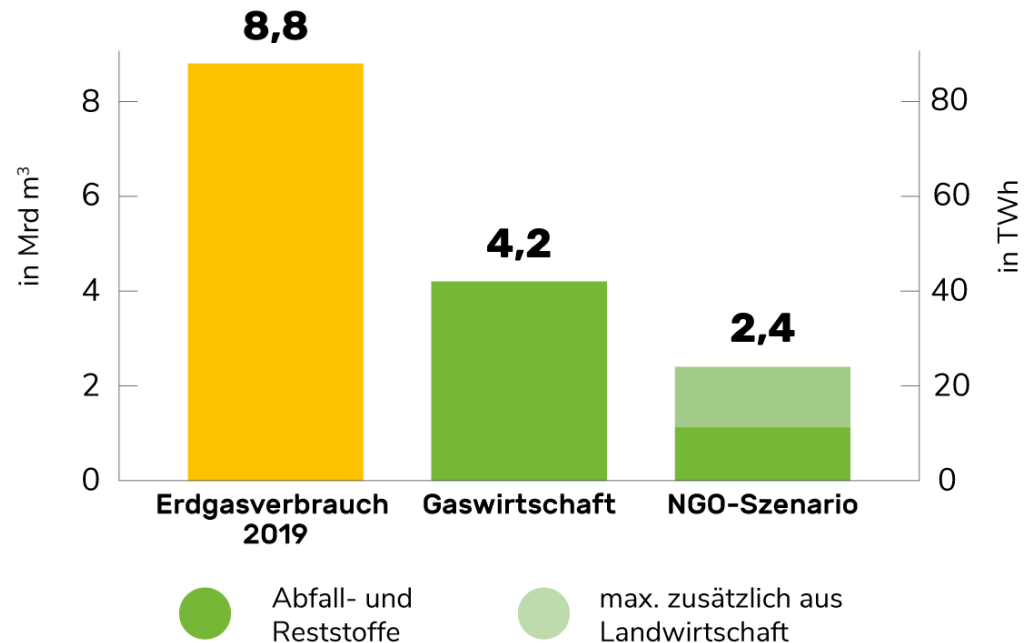
„Greening the Gas“

Maximale Biomethanpotenziale der Gaswirtschaft und des NGO-Szenarios im Vergleich zum aktuellen Erdgasverbrauch.

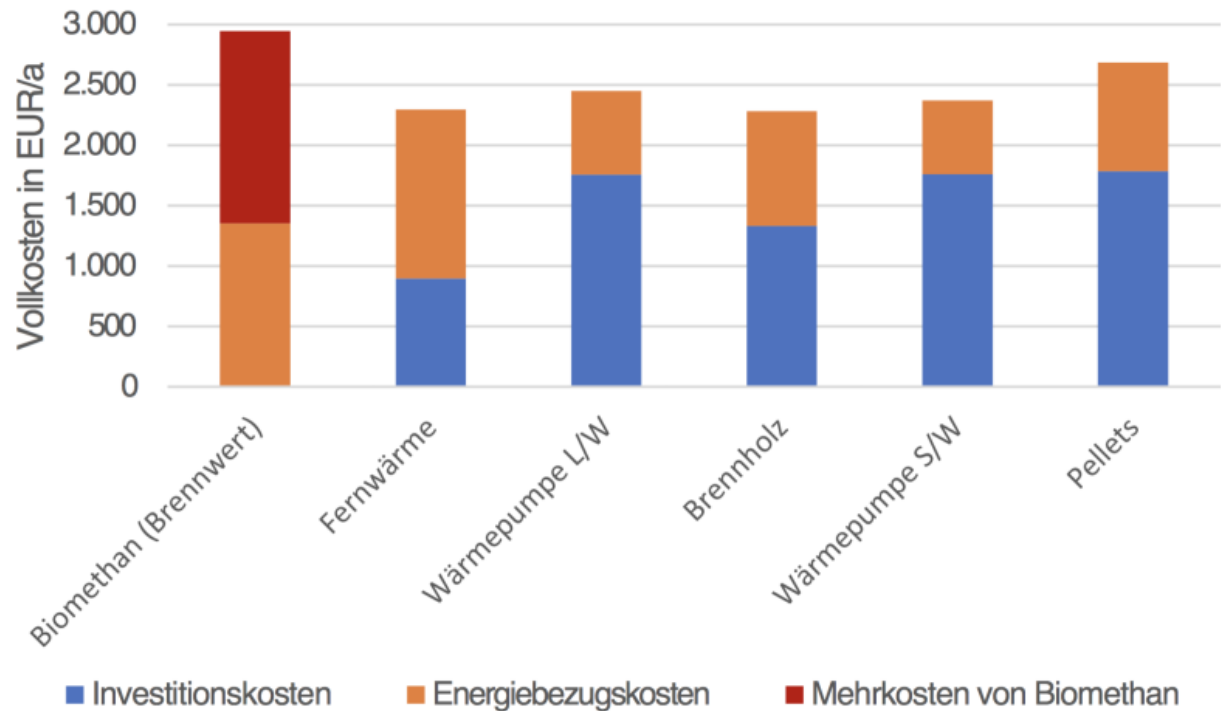
- Green Gas has to be prioritised
